MUG Leaders are experienced UBC students who guide new-to-UBC students through orientation and support them as a peer coach from September 2012 through to December 2012. The MUG Leader position runs from March 2012 to December 2012.

As a MUG Leader you will:

- 1) Attend monthly training sessions in 2012 second term
 - Two day training in March (One half day and one full day of weekend in late March)
- 2) Attend additional training
 - Contribute to online MUG community – completion of online components
 - Campus tour skills
 - Situational based coaching practice
 - Knowledge of resources and roles
 - MUG Leader development training – September 2nd
 - Imagine Logistics Run-Through – September 3rd
 - Imagine UBC – September 4th
 - Attend Monthly Check-in/Professional Development Meetings in September and October to prepare you for the commitments outlined below.
- 3) Commit to coaching MUG students September – December 2012: A total of 1-2 hours/biweekly.
 - Lead an excellent Imagine UBC day by providing a campus tour, tips for student success, and by helping new-to-UBC students feel at ease at their new school
 - Build community with your MUG group by a combination of following:
 - Attend two events with MUG group during the Fall term such as “Meet your Profs” or the CLASS Conference
 - Facilitate 3 online reflection meetings with students (Themes will be supplied)
 - Volunteer with SPACs Deal with December Now workshops
 - Provide academic resources to new students
 - Send out a bi-weekly check in/newsletter sent to first year students (email, phone, Facebook, Skype)
 - Continue to be a Peer Coach in term 2 (Optional)
- 4) As a MUG Leader you will:
 - Gain group facilitation, problem-solving, and trouble-shooting experience
 - Work with a diverse group of students
 - Gain valuable coaching skills, communication and presentation skills
 - Be an ambassador to UBC and help to build a community with students in the Faculty of Science
