Brushes is a digital finger painting application originally created from scratch for the iPhone, but redesigned to take full advantage of the iPad's larger screen. Featuring a simple yet deep interface, highquality brushes, multiple layers, and extreme zooming, it is a powerful tool for creating original artwork,

You can import photo and draw on them (to illustrate a point of highlight a concept) anyplace and anytime.

Unlike other apps, Brushes records every brush stroke and erasure as you paint. Afterwards, you can use Brushes Viewer, a free application for Mac OS X, to replay your painting stroke by stroke. You can also export the painting at very high resolutions (up to 4608 x 6144), or export the replay as a QuickTime movie.
