Practice Activity #1

Experiencing WebCT Vista as a Student

- 1. Log into the training server WITH THE ID & PASSWORD PROVIDED BY THE INSTRUCTOR
- **2.** Enter "Vista Bootcamp I" and browse around the student site
- 3. Browse through the Learning Modules
- **4.** Post a discussion message in <u>Unit 1: Are Humans</u> contributing to Climate Change?
- 5. Try out Quiz 1
- **6.** View the Media Glossary
- **7.** Return to your Course List, by clicking on **my Vista** at the top right of the screen

Practice Activity #1

Add/Remove Tools on the Course Menu

- In the BUILD TAB, under Designer Tools, click on Manage Course
- Click on Tools
- Click on the small box to the left of the Syllabus Tool
- Click on the small box to the left of the Goals Tool
- Scroll to the bottom of your page and click Save.

Hide a Tool

- In the BUILD TAB, under Designer Tools, click on Manage Course
- Click on Course Menu
- o On the Goals, click on Hide Link (to the right)
- You should see an (H) now beside Assignments on the Course Tools
- o In Student View, this item is now hidden from students

Practice Activity #2

Using the Roster Tool

- In the BUILD TAB, under Course Tools, click on Roster
- o Browse through Instructor, Students and Groups tabs

Practice Activity #3

Using the Mail Tool

- In the BUILD TAB, under Course Tools, click on Mail
- Click Create Message
- Click Browse for Recipient
- In the Subject: enter text
- o In the empty Message: box, enter text
- Click either Send or Preview

Practice Activity #4

Create a Gradable Discussion

- In either BUILD or TEACH tabs, click on Discussions
- Click on Create Topic
- Select Threaded Topic (explore Journal and Blog options)
- Enter a title "Should we grow trees to remove carbon in the atmosphere?"
- Enter **Description** (optional)
- In Category, click on the dropdown menu
- Select Create New Category and type Unit 4 Topics
- In Grading, click "Numeric grade: Out of " and type in "3".
- Click on 'Release grade to Students in My Grades'
- Click on Topic Behaviour Options and browse through settings. Leave defaults and click Save.

Part II

- Click on Student View
- On the Course Tools, click on Discussions
- View your new **Discussions** topic
- Post a message to this new discussion topic

Practice Activity #5

Create an Assessment (Quiz)

- o In the BUILD TAB, under Course Tools, click on Assessments
- o Browse through existing assessments
- Click on Create Assessment called "Pre-Course Quiz"
- In *Type* settings, select **Quiz**



- In Template settings, leave default "Do not base on an existing "
- Click on Save
- You will now see your new assessments in the list "Pre-Course Quiz (HIDDEN)"
- Note: The quiz will remain HIDDEN until questions are added and then you must "Show Item".

Practice Activity #6

Adding Questions to a Quiz

- Click on the new underlined "Pre-Course Quiz"
- Click on **Create Questions** from drop down menu and select **Multiple Choice**
- In the Title field, type "precourseQ1"
- In the Question text: box, type this question <u>"Which one of the following is NOT included in Earth's climate system?"</u> and enter in the answers below:

\circ	hydrosphere
0	solid Earth
0	Solarsphere (correct answer)
\circ	atmosphere
0	biosphere

- O Click on More Options
- Type some General feedback in the box example: 'Nice Work on the Ouiz' and click Save
- On the PrecourseQuiz ActionLinks at the top of the page, click the dropdown menu select Preview , then select Show Item
- o Go into **Student View**, and try your new **PreCourse Quiz**



Practice Activity #7

Creating a Learning Modules

In Student View, click on Learning Modules and browse Unit 1

- Click on BUILD TAB
- o Click on Learning Modules on the Course Tools
- Click Create Learning Module
- Enter a title "Unit 3 The Greenhouse Gases"
- Click on Save

Practice Activity #8

Adding Content (i.e. documents) to Your Module

- Click on the new "Unit 3 The Greenhouse Gases" learning module in the list
- o Click on Add File
- Click on Browse for Files
- Click on <u>Class Files >> Imported Resources >> Course Contents</u>
 <u>>> Unit 3 The Green Gases</u>
- Select all documents in the list
- Click OK
- Go into Student View and click on Learning Modules

Practice Activity #9

Part I - Adding Content Links to Your Module

- Click on BUILD TAB
- o Click on Learning Modules on the Course Tools menu
- Click on 'Unit 3 The Greenhouse Gases'
- Click on Add Content Link
- Scroll down to Assessements
- Scroll down and click on Unit 3 Quiz Greenhouse Gases
- Click on Add Selected
- You should see a Quiz now in your learning module

Part II

- Click on Add Content Link
- Perform the same steps as above and add the following:
 - Assignment (select <u>Unit 3 Assignment</u>)

- Weblink
- Unit 3 Discussions
- Click on Student View and click on Learning Modules, browse
 Unit 3

Part III

- Click on Build Tab
- Click on Learning Modules, and select Unit 3
- Click on Create Heading
- Enter title "Unit 3" and click Save
- Perform the same steps again and create headings called *Unit* 3 Quiz, Unit 3 Assignment, Unit 3 Discussions, and Weblinks

Practice Activity #10

Adding a Learning Module to your Homepage (Organizer Page)

- Click on the Build Tab
- Click on Course Content icon you should now be on the homepage
- Click on Add Content Link
- Scroll down to Learning Module
- Select all modules in the list
- Click on Student View
- Browse through the modules available on the homepage
- o Optional: Can also put all modules in a **FOLDER**

Practice Activity #11

Freeze Column Feature in the Gradebook

- Click on the Teach Tab
- o On the Instructor Tools at the bottom, click on **Grade Book**
- Click on Grade Book Options
- On the drop down menu, click on **Freeze Columns**
- Click once on any row and then scroll along the now highlighted row

Practice Activity #12

Finding Members in the Gradebook

o Click on Grade Book Options

- Click on Find Members
- In the Column: drop down menu box, scroll down and select Lab Section
- In the Value: box enter "101"
- Click on Run Query
- All 101 members will be displayed
- Click in the small box to the left of the LAST NAME column



- o All Lab101 students should now be highlighted in grey
- o At the bottom of the page, click on **Send Mail**

To view All students again:

- Click on Grade Book Options
- Click on **Show All Members**
