




Storyboard:How to add a blog post.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Hi everyone, in this tutorial I am going to show you how to add a blog post to the Digital Tattoo site.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> First, go to http://cms.ubc.ca/ Click on the CWL login button
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Click on “Visit Dashboard/” beside the “Digital Tattoo” site

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- This is the interface for creating a blog. First, in the area that says “Add New Post”, type the title of the blog. I will type “What shapes your digital identity?” as an example.



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

You will be typing the blog post content in this field. You can switch the editing mode to Visual or Text mode. In visual mode, the interface is similar to Microsoft word. You can bold the text or add links easily.



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You can switch to text mode, which allows you to add HTML. So if you are familiar with HTML, you can choose to edit in HTML mode. For this tutorial, I will be using visual mode.

	<p>I will be typing my content now. I can highlight on the text, make it to a header and I can add bullet points.</p>
	<p>If you want to add links, you can highlight on text, and click on the insert link button.</p>
	<p>You can add external links or internal links in here. If I want to add an external link, I just type the URL of the external link here,</p> <p>and if I want to add a link to pages in Digital Tattoo site, I select the pages from the list here.</p> <p>I will add external links this time.</p> <p>Also, I choose “Open link in a new tab” so that when the site visitors click on the link, the link will open in a new window.</p>

	<p>In addition to links, you can also add an image. Click on “add Media” to insert the image.</p> <p>You can choose to select the existing media from gallery, or choose to upload files. When you upload files, make sure to include citation, and add alt text. In alt text, add a text that describes what the image look like</p> <p>I will upload the icon that I created . In my case, I will cite the image as “Tick” by the Digital Tattoo Project and alternative text will be “tick in a checkbox”</p>
	<p>Now, I finish with my content. If I want to save my work, I click on “Save Draft”. At this point, your blog post is not published yet.</p>

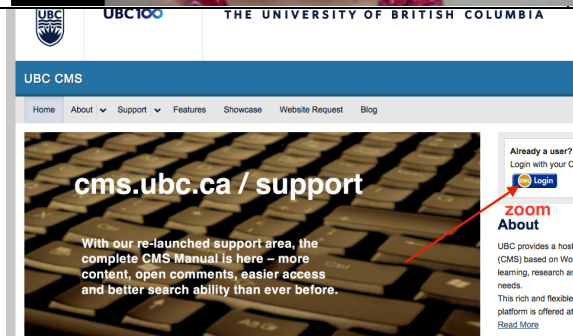

And Discuss which is the comment section.



Scroll down, and look for the text that says "Put the gravity form here" highlight the text, and click on the "Add form" button. Select the gravity form quiz that you have created in the previous video.</p>

In the area that it says "This is where you can add the content for Explore, type the content. You can also add delicious feed from this shortcode. To add a delicious feed, Go to https://delicious.com/ Log in to delicious using the account from Digital Tattoo.</p>
	<p>After you login, click on Add "links" add the links that you would like to add. For example, I will add a link. Then, add a title of the link, and type a brand new tag for the page you are creating. For example, if I am creating a new page about online gaming, I will be adding a new tag called "texting app" You can add multiple tags to the link, when you put comma.</p>
	<p>Then, when you add another link, type in the tag that you have created previously. Repeat this process.</p>

Under discussion question, type in a question for the comments. For example, If the content is about texting app, you can create a question like "If your past logs for text becomes publicly available, will that affect your digital identity?"</p>
	<p>Then, set a featured image, make sure the image size 260 x 230 px</p>
	<p>Under page attribution, select a parent page. If the page you created is part of the "Protect" page, select "Protect."</p>
	<p>Click on Publish, and make sure that comments are activated. Now You're done!!</p>

Storyboard: CSS Best practices

	<p>In this video, I am going to go over with some of best practices in CSS. The browser that I am currently using is Chrome.</p> <p>In the Digital Tattoo website,</p>
	<p>we are using a plugin called custom CSS to override the CSS on the website .</p> <p>When you make changes to CSS, you can see the changes on the screen. Until you press the “Save” button, this changes will not be visible to anyone else.</p>

	<p>In Chrome you can right click, and select inspect elements to find out what classes or IDs are used in certain parts of the website . For example, in here, you can see that .widget-title class is affecting the styling in How do I earn a badge</p>
	<p>You can copy this, and over-ride changes in custom CSS.</p> <p>I will be going over best practices on CSS.</p>

For example, if I make any changes to font color , I will be making changes on CSS in here.</p>
