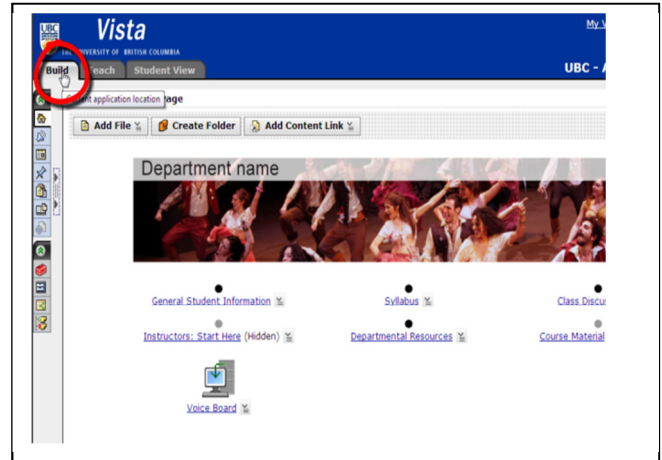


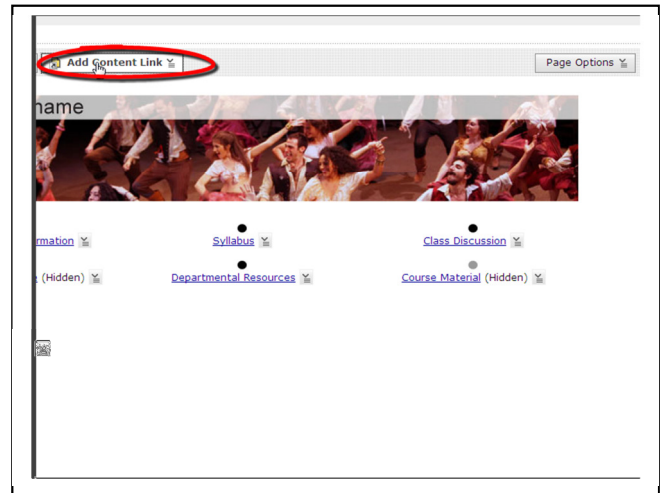

Creating a Turnitin Link

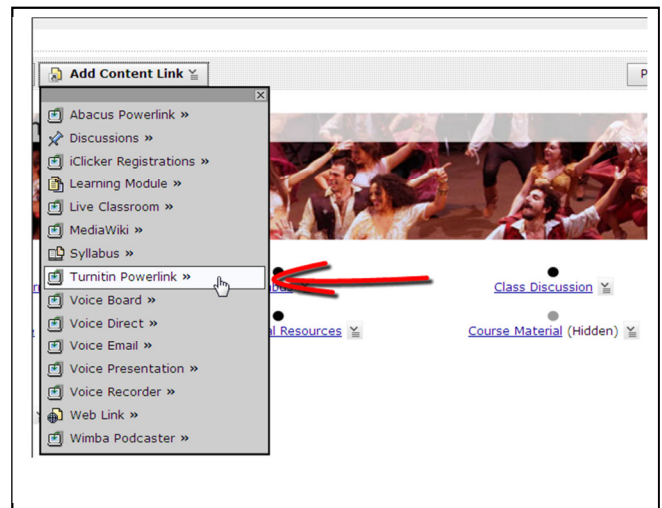
1. Make sure you are in the Build tab.



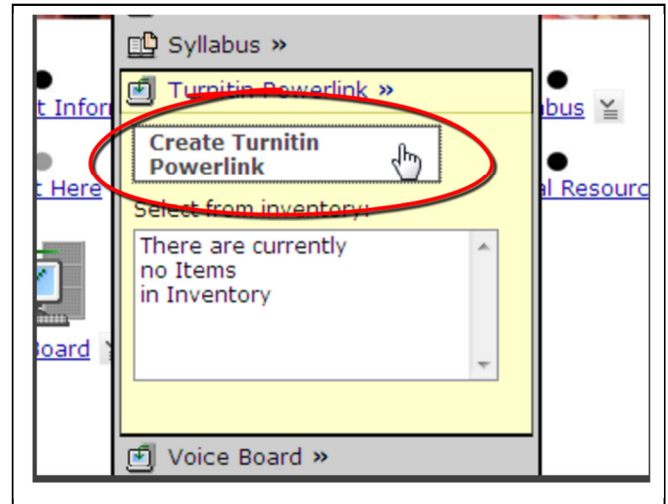
2. Click on "Add Content Link".



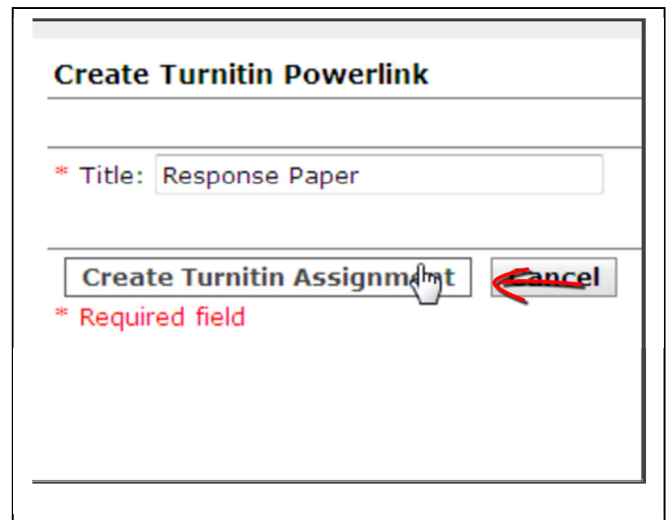
3. Click on "Turnitin Powerlink".



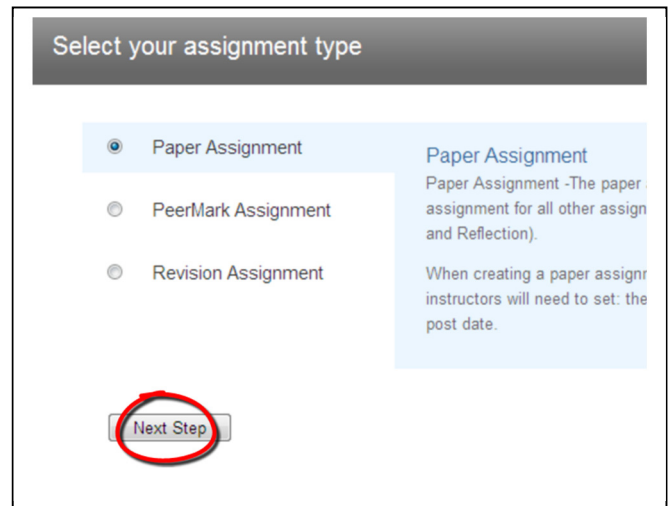
4. Click on "Create Turnitin Powerlink".



5. Assign a title and click on "Create Turnitin Assignment".



6. Select the assignment type and click "Next Step".
(In this example, I will select Paper Assignment)



7. Assign a **Title** and **Point value**

8. Next, enter the **Dates**.

Start Date: The date when the assignment is available for students to submit their paper.

Due Date: The date when the assignment is due.

Post Date: The date when students are able to see their grades in Turnitin. However students are able to see their grades in the Gradebook unless changed.
