Connect and Ground within Culture:

music, food, tradition, religious and spiritual beliefs, rest,
unplug from social etc.

Resistance:

challenging anger with inner strengths, remaining informed,
changing practice, protest, vocalizing etc.

Internal Resourcefulness:

reflecting on teaching from elders, positive affirmations,
reflecting on past success celebrating everything,
banking confidence etc.

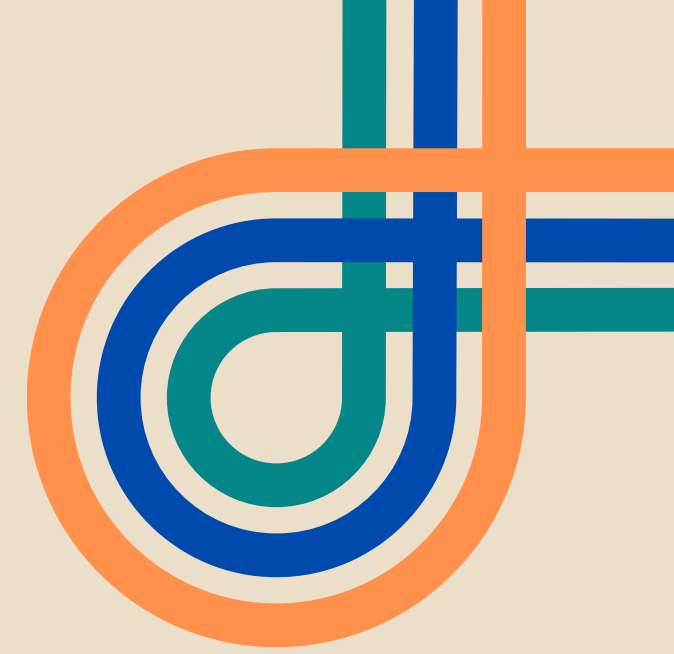
