# **October**

## **Position Posting**

Wednesday, Oct 5<sup>th</sup> OPC to discuss Squad Leader position and recruitment

**Friday, October 7**<sup>th</sup> Joey/Shannon have updated SL position description and application requirements (cover letter and resume) and distributed to distribute to faculty SDOs/SDCs by this date – moved to Oct 11<sup>th</sup>

**Thursday October 13<sup>th</sup>** Faculty SDOs/SDCs to return edited SL position description to specify Faculty/School requirements to Joey

• Squad Leaders apply through central system as previous years

**End of day Thursday, October 13<sup>th</sup>** Joey will have circulate final posting and position descriptions to SDOs/SDCs by this date

Thursday, October 13<sup>th</sup> Joey to post on Careers Online

# Wednesday, October 19<sup>th</sup> (at the latest)

- 1. News of posting to be distributed in the following ways by end of day at the latest:
  - **a.** Faculty to email their 2011 SLs that the postings are up, and ask them to let the MLs/GLs in their group that they thought were particularly great know.
  - **b.** Faculty contacts and SD staff to distribute to their specific student networks, targeting students they think would be excellent
  - c. To be featured on the UBC FYI blog (Date?)
  - **d.** To be featured on the <u>www.involvement.ubc.ca</u> website (I can't remember if this was the plan)

Wednesday, October 26<sup>th</sup> Applications due at the end of the day

#### **Interview Documents**

**Tuesday, October 18<sup>th</sup>** Working group made up of \_\_\_\_\_\_ and Joey to establish selection questions for SLs, to be sent to Faculty contacts by this date

**Friday, October 28**<sup>th</sup> Faculty contacts to add any personalized interview questions for their Faculty/provide any general feedback and send Joey the final version of their questions to be archived on the LAN by this date.

Monday, October 24<sup>th</sup> An interview rubric to aid in the assessment of leaders will be provided by Joey by the end of day

**Thursday, October 27<sup>th</sup>** The final calendar of Squad Leader dates reflecting changes to recruitment, selection, and training of other Orientation Leaders will be distributed by this date.

# **Selection for Interviews**

**Thursday, October 27**<sup>th</sup> O-Team to collect applications and distribute faculty-specific applications to SDOs/SDCs (organization ongoing, send during the afternoon.

Monday, October 31<sup>st</sup> Short-listing of candidates by Faculty contacts by end-of-day and sent back to O-team

## Interviews

 O-Team to manage logistics of interview scheduling (with *Flash Appointments*), headed up by <u>OTC.</u>

**Friday, October 14**<sup>th</sup> Faculty contacts to confirm involvement in interview process including the number of hours of interviews they are able to do, and/or that their faculty colleagues are able to do (example International Faculty Contacts)

Wednesday, October 26<sup>th</sup> Faculty contacts to confirm precise date and times of availability for the indicated number of hours (+1 or 2 for easier scheduling) between Thursday, November 3<sup>rd</sup> and Wednesday, November 23<sup>rd</sup> for interviews. Please also indicate <u>where</u> you would like your interviews to take place; if you have your own office, it will be the ideal location for interviews as we'll know it's available.

- a. Interview panel to include one of the following combinations:
  - Best: Professional staff faculty contact with O-Team member, ex. Tannis and Ricky
  - **2<sup>nd</sup> best:** Professional staff non-faculty specific with faculty-specific student staff member, ie. Co-op. , ex. Evan and Amelie
  - Also good: Two full time staff, at least one faculty-specific, ex. Winnie and Joey

# November

## Interviews

**Tuesday, November 1**<sup>st</sup> O-Team to send out invitations for interviews to SL candidates asking them to book themselves in via *Flash Appointments* during one of the timeslots their faculty reps are available.

**Wednesday, November 23<sup>rd</sup>** Interviews to be completed by end of day. Faculty-contacts to prepare interview sheets etc for all interviews.

#### **Selection for Offers**

**Friday, November 4**<sup>th</sup> O-Team to send out common messaging to faculty contacts to use when making offers to SLs by this date. This will include a link to a survey for SL candidates to verify their availability for all SL calendar dates or to flag any conflicts.

**Thursday, November 24<sup>th</sup>** Faculty contacts to send to Woo the names of SL candidates they think would be good for GALA by end of day

Friday, November 25<sup>th</sup> O-Team to make GALA SL offers

Friday, November 25<sup>th</sup> Faculty contacts to make offers to successful Imagine SL candidates by end of day

**Monday, November 28<sup>th</sup>** Faculty contacts to send list of accepted SLs to O-Team by this date for compilation in our files and preparation for first BOO Meeting.

November 30<sup>th</sup>/December 1<sup>st</sup>/First week of January? First BOO Meeting
