

## How to Create Group Discussion Boards.

1. Make sure you are in the Teach tab.


2. Click on "Group Manager" under the Instructor Tools.




4. Check off any group(s)











5. In "Create Group Activity," click on the blue arrow and select "Discussion Topic"



6. Next, click the "Go" button which is the "green arrow" button.




7. Now choose your desired type of the discussion topic. Please read the description of the types if you are not familiar with them.

To the right displays a preview of how each would look like.




8. Threaded topic is the most widely used. I will select that as my example.


Click "Next"




9. Enter the title of the discussion board.




10. Next, if applicable, assign the board to a category.




11. Under grading, by default the boards are setup to be nongradable. If you want the topics to be gradable, select "Numberic" and assign a value.




12. Make sure to also go through the "Student Posting Rules" in case you want to limit student's access participating in the discussion board.




13. When you are done, click "Save"



14. Now return to "Discussions" to see if the discussion board has been created based on the group that was selected.



15. Notice in my example Group 1's discussion board was successfully created.
